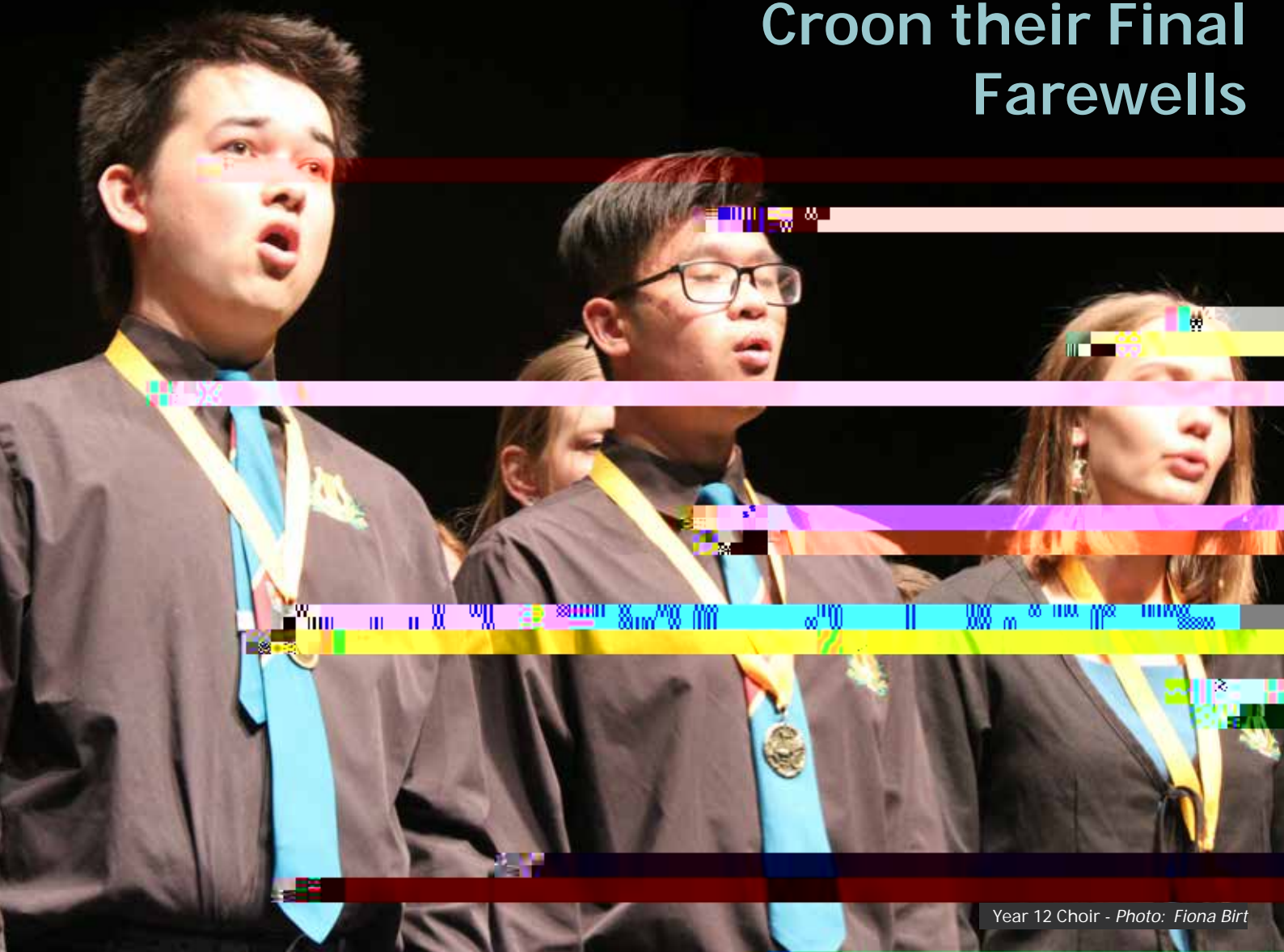

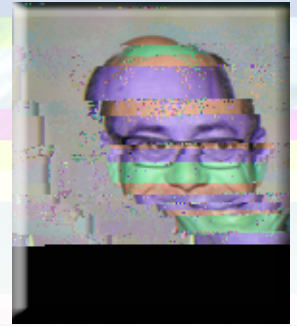

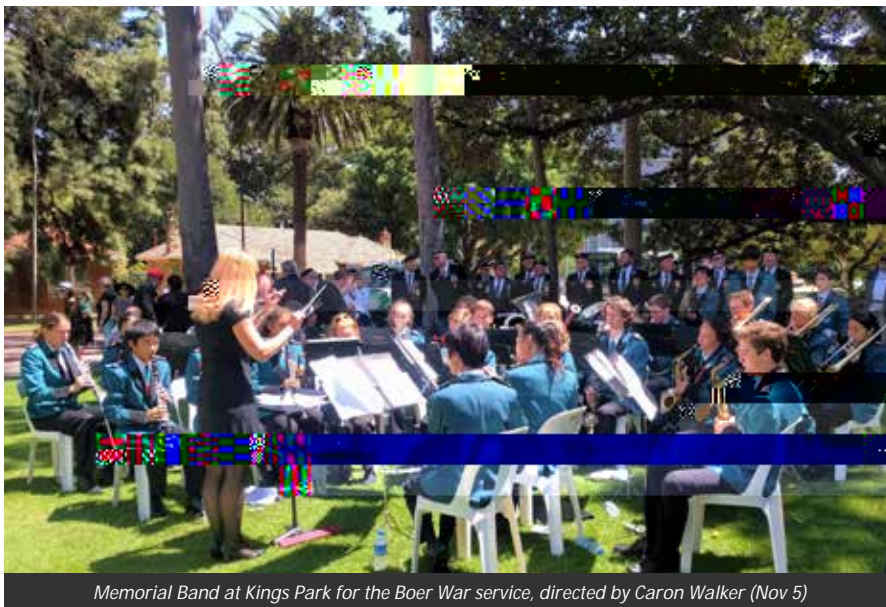

Year 6 Parents Info Night

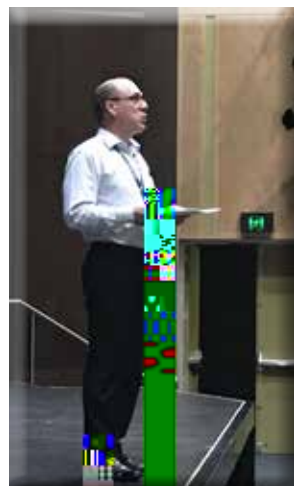

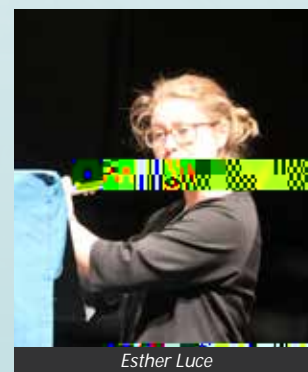

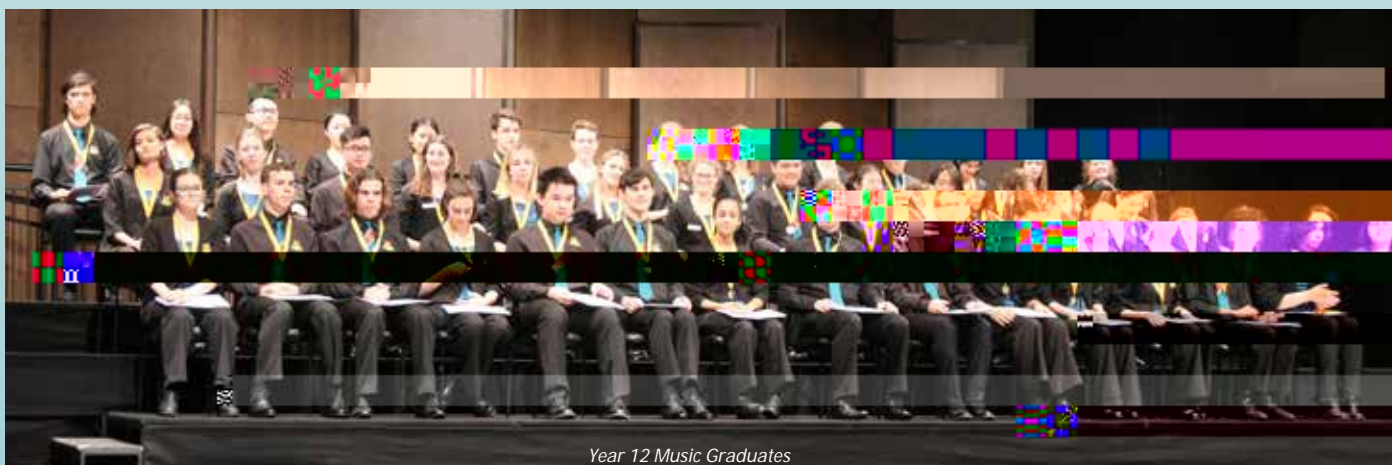
